Name a work of art by the artist:

- Born in 1907, in Coyoacán, Mexico.
- Involved in a tragic accident at age 18.
- Married an artist.
- Inspired by Mexican culture and heritage and often wore traditional Mexican attire and jewelry.
- Painted many self-portraits.
- This artist's "Blue House" is now a museum.

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Name a work of art by the artist:

- Born in 1917, in Atlantic City, New Jersey, USA.
- Studied art at the Harlem Workshop and the American Artists School.
- Used narrative paintings to tell the story of the Great Migration.
- In 1942, this artist was drafted into the United States Coast Guard.
- Completed a series of paintings about Harriet Tubman.

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Name a work of art by the artist:

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- Born in 1760, in Edo, Japan.
- At age 15, became an apprentice, as a woodcut engraver.
- This artist had MANY different names.
- Famous for a series of prints featuring the tallest mountain in Japan.
- This artist's woodcut print, "The Great Wave" inspired many artists.

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Name a work of art by the artist:

- Born in 1632, in Delft, The Netherlands.
- Paintings often featured domestic life.
- May have been inspired by an interest in the camera obscura.
- This artist's paintings had brilliant shades of blue, red and yellow.
- One of this artist's paintings inspired a novel and a movie.

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Name a work of art by the artist:

- Born in 1928, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, USA.
- Worked as a graphic artist in an advertising agency.
- Had an art workshop called "The Factory."
- Used silk-screening.
- Explored popular culture and used images of brands such as Campbell's soup.
- Often wore dark sunglasses.
